

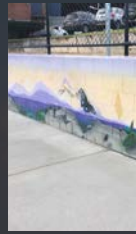
# Nambour Public Art Trail

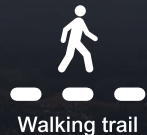
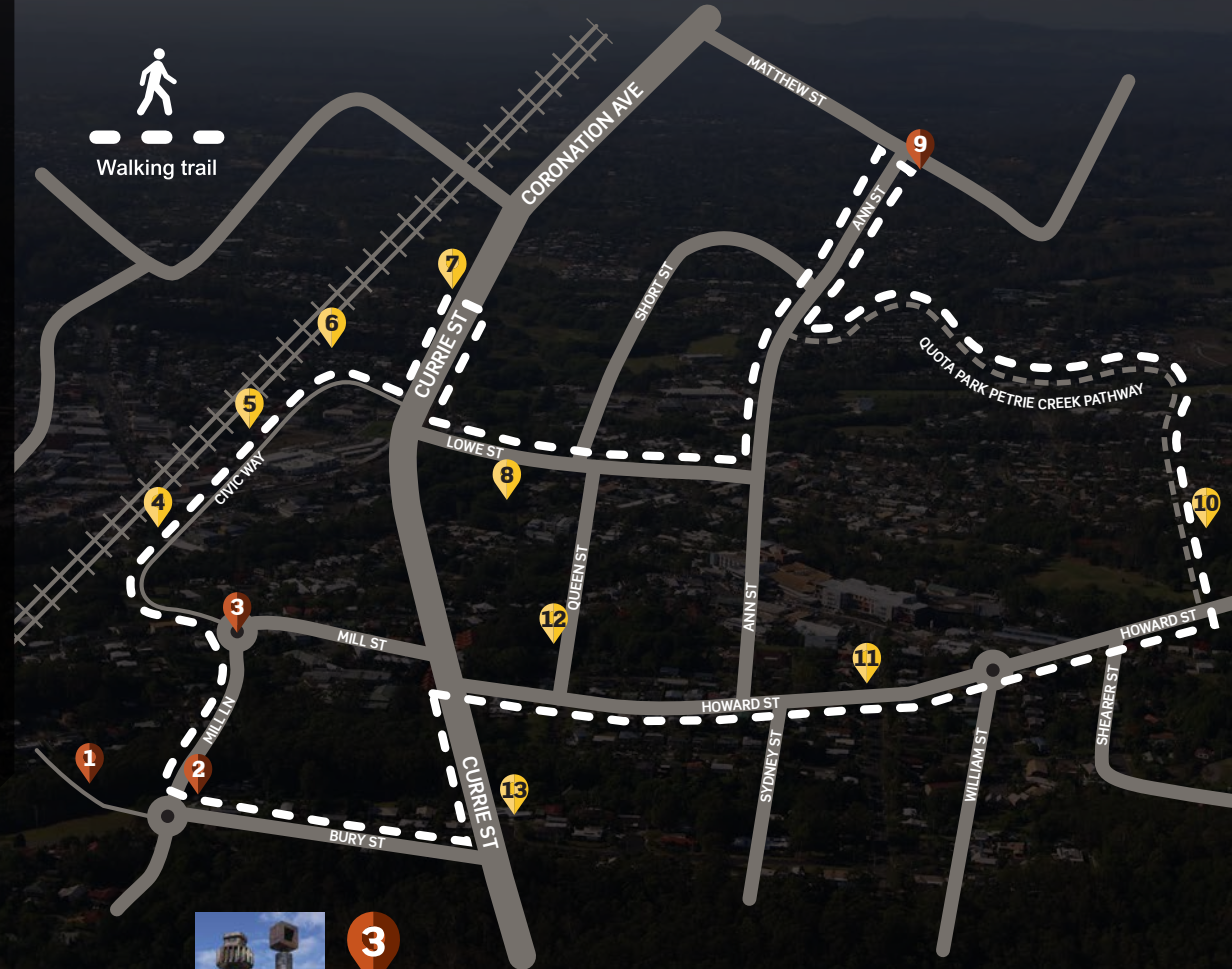
